Dear Mr. Johnson:

You recently talked with representatives of this hepartment concerning the need for your continued compliance with Fish and Game regulations and laws concerning oyster culture. Apparently you felt that the recent inclusion of tide and submirged lands at Pt. Reyes into the National Senshore removed your oyster allotments from State jurisdiction.

Upon reviewing the law transferring these lands to the Federal Government, it appears to us that all State Laws and regulations pertaining to shellfish cultivation (including planting requirements, land rental stc.) remain in effect since the conveyance by the Legislature reserves fishery rights to the State.
