Point Reyes National Seashore and Regulation of Johnson Oyster Company

Attached is a copy of a letter recently received from L. P. Arnberger, Park Superintendent of Point Reyes National Seashore, requesting information relating to regulation of the Johnson Oyster Company by the Park Service.

It is our understanding, earlier set forth in our letter of October 22, 1965, (copy enclosed) to Johnson Oyster Co., that the law transferring the submerged lands to the Federal Government specifically reserved the fishing rights to the State.

We enclose a draft of a suggested letter to Mr. Arnberger for your comments and approval.
